Easy Maintenance for Your Artificial Turf

Maintaining your synthetic lawn is a breeze compared to natural grass. No more mowing, fertilizing, or excessive watering needed for a beautiful green yard.

The level of maintenance required depends on your specific situation but with a little care, your artificial lawn will stay pristine for years to come.

1. Keep It Clear of Debris

Use a leaf rake or carpet rake to clear fallen leaves, branches, and other debris from your artificial grass. This simple step helps maintain a clean and groomed appearance. We recommend the Grandi Groom carpet rake, available online for around \$40.

2. Gentle Watering

Give your lawn a gentle spray each month to remove dust, dirt, and pollen. Occasional watering also helps prevent infill from settling unevenly. During the first 4-6 weeks after installation, avoid excessive watering to allow the base to set. **Refrain from heavy traffic after heavy rainfall.**

3. Pet Care

Cleaning up after your furry friends is easy on artificial grass. Use plastic bags or pooper scoopers to remove solid waste, then hose down the area. Routine rinsing will keep your lawn smelling fresh and odor-free. Look for enzymatic cleaning products specifically designed for pet care maintenance.

4. Handling Spills and Stains

Don't fret over spills or stains – our artificial grass is stain-resistant and easy to clean. For spills, simply rinse with water. Tougher stains can be tackled with a mild soap and warm water, or a mixture of equal parts vinegar and water. Act quickly for best results.

5. Preventing Matting

To prevent matting and maintain the beauty of your turf, follow these tips:

- Regular Brushing: Brushing brush your artificial turf regularly with a stiff-bristled brush will help to maintain the upright position of the fibers and prevent matting.
- Prompt Debris Removal: Promptly remove any debris such as leaves, twigs, or pet waste to prevent them from weighing down the turf and causing matting.
- Minimize Heavy Focused Traffic Patterns: Minimize routine heavy foot traffic on the turf, especially in concentrated areas, to reduce wear and prevent matting.
- Use Turf-Friendly Cleaning Products: We recommend using only turf-friendly cleaning products when necessary to avoid damaging the fibers and compromising their resilience against matting.
- Avoid Sharp Objects: We caution against placing sharp objects or furniture with narrow legs directly on the turf, as these items or similar can cause damage to the fibers and lead to matting.

6. Recommended Cleaning Products For general cleaning, we recommend the following:

Enzyme cleaners like PE51 (available at www.zeofill.com) or Wysiwash (www.wysiwash.com)

5% white distilled vinegar (do not dilute) "Green cleaners" that are biodegradable, non-foaming, and low-suds

A 5-10% solution of bleach and water (rinse well afterward)

Avoid cleaners containing alcohol or harsh acids, as they can damage the turf blades. Use approximately 1 gallon for every 500 square feet of turf, adjusting as needed for heavily soiled areas. Rinse well after cleaning, using a garden sprinkler or hose with a shower setting.

With these simple tips, your artificial turf will stay looking lush and inviting, giving you more time to enjoy your outdoor space worry-free.
